## General Information

- University admission requires an OSSD and a minimum of six 4U or 4M courses.
- Math 4U is not a requirement for all universities programs.

- We strongly recommend that you consider co-op! A great way to obtain credits and experience in a field of interest. Please discuss with Mr. Hamelinck.

## OSSD REQUIREMENTS

In order to receive a high school diploma, each student needs to complete **30 credits** which include:

- .5 CIVICS
- .5 CAREER STUDIES
- 1 GROUP 1 ELECTIVE (FRENCH, SOC. SCIENCE, ETC)
- 1 GROUP 2 ELECTIVE (PE, ART BUSINESS, ETC)
- 1 GROUP 3 ELECTIVE (SCIENCE, TECH, ETC)
